GUIDELINES FOR STARTING LESSONS BACK

- We will have private/individual lessons, or up to 3 independent riders at a time until we are able to resume normal classes.
- Community room, viewing area and stable area will be closed to family/spectators.
- Bathroom only available in an emergency! Must wash hands!
- Bring your own water/beverage if needed.
- Horses will be tacked and ready to go by the instructor.
- Riders should arrive on time for their class, please stay in your car until called to mount your horse, please be on time.
- Family members who are a volunteer may be the rider's leader, all other people please stay at home or in the car.
- All instructors/volunteers/riders must wear a mask while mounting & dismounting. Please bring a mask/bandana with you. All riders must wear gloves while riding.
- Social distancing is imperative; the CDC guidelines are at least 6' apart.
- All tack/equipment & horse will be sanitized after each lesson.
- After each ride, the student will dismount and leave immediately, there will be no grooming or caring for their horses for now.
- Please bring hand sanitizer with you, we are unable to find supplies for everyone.
- If you or the rider does not feel well/sick, do not come. You will not be allowed to ride.

No one ever thought this pandemic was possible. If we all follow CDC guidelines and our guidelines, we will be able to continue with this recreational activity. Thank you, be safe and be well!
